

Pool Rules and Regulations

The Club at Hillbrook has established the following Rules and Regulations for the safeguarding of its members and guests and the protection of its property and to provide enjoyable recreation for all.

- Use of swimming pool is for The Club at Hillbrook Full Members, their spouse, children (under the age of 23 and living at home) and their accompanied guests.
- Members and their guests are required to sign in at the check-in table. Children over the age of 23 are considered a guest and must be signed in. Applicable guest fees and food and beverage items will be billed to the members' club account.
 - Guest fees: Weekdays (Tues-Fri): \$8.00/guest * Weekends (Sat, Sun) & Holidays: \$10.00/guest
- Guests must be accompanied by a Hillbrook member at all times.
- Members are responsible for all damage done by themselves and their guests.
- No person may use or enter the pool area at any time unless a lifeguard is on duty.
- Children 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult; Children under the age of 7 must be accompanied to and in the pool by an adult.
- Swim diapers or rubber pants must be worn without exception by children not yet "toilet trained". Parents whose children cause a pool closure will be held responsible for all costs incurred.
- Walk, NO running. No diving, pushing, dunking or horseplay.
- Rafts and other large flotation devices and toys are prohibited. Pool noodles are permitted.
- No distracting or talking to the lifeguards, unless asking for help.
- No smoking in or around the pool area.
- Outside food and beverage of any form and coolers of any form are prohibited.
- No cans or glass of any kind is permitted in the pool area.
- Pool towels are available, one (1) towel per swimmer. Please return to towel bin upon exiting the pool area.
- Bathing attire is prohibited in or about any part of the club, except the immediate pool and locker area. Shoes must always be worn to and from the locker rooms. Complete cover-ups and shoes are required when in transit to and from the pool.
- At the discretion of the lifeguard, a 10-minute safety break may be called, no more than one (1) per hour. At this time, all patrons must exit the pool and may not return until the lifeguard gives the "OK". The safety break will allow the lifeguard a chance to get down from the lifeguard chair, stretch their legs, get a drink of water and cool off in the pool.
- Management reserves the right to make adjustments in daily operating hours at any time, without advance notice, including closing the pool due to cold or inclement weather, safety reasons, repairs and maintenance, or for any reason as deemed necessary by management.
- The pool will close 30 minutes for thunder and/or lightening. At this time, all members and guests must exit the pool area. If thunder and/or lightening persist, additional time will be added.
- The Club at Hillbrook assumes no liability for any loss or damage to the property of any member or guest.
- Personal items such as pool noodles, toys, goggles, clothing must be taken with you upon leaving the pool for the day. Overnight storage in locker rooms is prohibited.

Saturday: 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Sunday: 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Poolside food and beverage service: Tuesday - Sunday 11:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The Club at Hillbrook may, at any time, with or without notice, change, add to, or delete from the rules of the Pool.
